

Flattop and Glen Alps Trailhead Geocaches

Flattop is Alaska's most visited peak. Other peaks, lakes and trails are also accessible from the Glen Alps Trailhead

Directions: From the New Seward Hwy., turn east on O'Malley Rd. from the New Seward Hwy, right on Hillside Dr., left on Upper Huffman, right on Toilsome Hill Dr. for 2 miles. \$5/day use fee.
